

MAYOR TO BUILD A HOUSE FOR A DESTITUTE FAMILY

PUDIAKGOPA: The rampant and unending housing service delivery backlog has forced the Mayor and her EXCO members on the ground to inspect and resolve this issue.

The Mogalakwena Municipality Mayor Her Worship Cllr Andrina Matsemela has delivered to the promise she made during her visit to Pudiakgopa village when she came across a family in dire need of an RDP house.

Following a thorough assessment of Mahata's family, Mayor promised that in no time she and the local business people would build a house for the family and indeed the bricks were delivered a few days later.

Mayor Matsemela was accompanied by the MEC for Rural Development and Agriculture Basikopo Makamu, Waterberg District Municipality Members of the Mayoral Committee, councillors and officials who came to witness the official opening of Taolome reservoir and the 8 500 bricks donation from Midway Bricks.
