

HONORING THE JOY OF LITERACY AND THE POWER OF WORDS

MOKOPANE: The Mogalakwena Local Municipality Libraries successfully hosted the final round of their Spelling Bee competition at Aboo Tayob Hall in Mokopane. A total of eighteen (18) learners from across the municipality took part in the competition.
