

WATER REMAINS A TOP PRIORITY FOR MOGALAKWENA LOCAL MUNICIPALITY

MOKOPANE: Mogalakwena Local Municipality (MLM) reiterates that access to water remains its highest service delivery priority, recognising water as essential to human health, economic development and environmental sustainability. As a responsible sphere of local government, the Municipality continues to address service delivery challenges across its jurisdiction, with water receiving first priority, followed by electricity and road infrastructure.

Following reports of water shortages received from Headmen Moeti and Langa, municipal officials promptly responded by dispatching water tankers to Pudiakgopa to provide relief to the affected community. The Municipality confirms that water tankers remain available and will continue to be deployed to address water shortages and related challenges where the need arises.

The Municipality further engaged with the community through a meeting held at the local community hall, during which residents raised their concerns. Subsequent to the engagement, residents returned to their households to allow for the efficient distribution of water by municipal tankers.

Mogalakwena Local Municipality remains committed to ensuring access to water for all communities and will continue to respond swiftly to water-related challenges as part of its service delivery mandate.
